



Today, I'm going to the hospital. Help Marty find his way to the hospital!







Step 1:


I first sit or lie in a comfortable position.

Step 4:


I like to say the word "calm" in my mind while breathing out.

Step 6:


I take a long, slower breath in and blow out slowly through my balloon. As I breathe out, I notice the scary feelings going away.




My most important job before my surgery is not to have anything to eat. Even though I am really hungry, I know it is important so my doctor can keep me safe.









When I'm more awake, I move to a comfy chair.
