<u>CATARACT DISCHARGE INFORMATION</u>

Advice For The First 24 Hours

- The first 24 hours: it is our policy that you have a Carer with you in attendance.
 - Attend your Post Op appointment as arranged by your Doctor.
 - Please have someone accompany you to your Post Op appointment and bring your eye drops & sunglasses.
 - *←* As you have had sedation **DO NOT:**
 - Drive a car
 Make important decisions
 - Drink alcohol Use machinery
 - Travel alone Lift heavy objects

Operated Eye

- Please keep the dressing dry and intact until tomorrow unless your Doctor has given you other instructions
- Please ensure your eye is closed under the dressing. Try not to sleep on the operated side.

Following your Surgery

- Ar You may experience some discomfort (grittiness, and or a mild dull ache),
- A During the healing process you may experience an itchy sensation;
- @ Please resist from rubbing or scratching your eye

Information about mobilization

Be Careful on steps and loose mats or reaching for hot liquids as your operated eye is covered and your depth perception is impaired.

For Pain

- A Panadeine, Panadol or Panamax As per package instructions.
- *⇔* If pain is not relieved by Panadeine or Panadol and pain *persists*:

Protecting Your Eye

- Avoid bumping, **RUBBING** or applying pressure to the eye.
- Avoid strenuous exercise & heavy lifting.
- Ladies, avoid wearing loose powder and eye make-up until instructed by your Doctor.
- A If instructed wear the plastic shield for sleeping and showering.

Caring For Your Eye

- You may cleanse the lids and lashes gently with a clean tissue and/ or with cooled boiled water as per your Doctors instructions.
- Applying your drops correctly will aid your recovery and can help prevent complications. Wash your hands before instilling eye-drops
- € Wear glasses or sunglasses when outdoors if you wish.
- extra care moving about, especially on stairs.



- & Avoid having any loose or slippery mats around your house.
- € If ointment is required necessary instructions will be issued.
- A Protect your eye whilst washing your face and hair.
- & You can read and watch TV.
- Return to normal recreational activities as per your Doctors instructions e.g. gardening
- € Do not go swimming without your doctor's approval
